In the city of Boynton Beach, within the county of Palm Beach, I Detective D. Whitefield, was assigned to investigate an armed robbery with a firearm that occurred within The District, an apartment complex located at 1000 Audace Avenue.

On February 24, 2020 at 2124 hours, BBPD officers were dispatched to the area of 1625 Renaissance Commons Blvd after witnesses observed a gray Ford Escape (FL tag 135OPY) drive up on the sidewalk, after which two young white or Hispanic males were observed exiting the vehicle and taking flight on foot while leaving the vehicle running. Witnesses advised that the passenger was wearing red pants and a black sweatshirt and the driver was wearing a red sweatshirt. The 911 call came in at 21:15 and as officers were responding (21:18), they were flagged down across the street at CVS (1895 N. Congress Ave) by a victim who claimed to have been robbed at gunpoint minutes prior inside The District (1000 Audace Ave). The location of the robbery is within one mile of where the Ford Escape had been abandoned by the two male subjects. It was learned that the vehicle had been reported stolen in West Palm Beach.

The victim stated that, as he was entering the main gate to The District, where he resides, he noticed a young Hispanic male sitting on the sidewalk near the entrance. The victim stated he continued to park his vehicle at the southwest corner of the parking lot (by building 1060) which is adjacent to a dog park, accessible by a small gate. As he was backing into a parking space, he noticed the same young male that he saw sitting near the front entrance, walk past his vehicle. The victim stated that the suspect then used the small access gate to the dog park and entered the driver seat of an older model gray Ford Escape which was running in the parking lot. Shortly after, a second Hispanic male exited the passenger seat. The victim stated that the second suspect was wearing a black and red plaid sweatshirt and red jogger pants. The victim stated that he exited his vehicle at which point the second suspect walked up and faced him, and pointed a small silver revolver handgun at him; he held the revolver with his left hand, at hip level and with one finger on the trigger. The victim stated that suspect then said, "I have nothing to live for, you need to give me everything or I will kill you". The victim stated that he was in fear for his life, so he removed his gold necklace with a gold Jesus face pendant, gold bracelet, watch, two Apple iPhones, and wallet, and handed them over (total loss \$19,170). The victim stated that the suspect then took the victim's vehicle key, told him to face away and proceeded to throw the key on the ground, which the victim later retrieved. The victim stated the the suspect reentered the passenger seat of the awaiting vehicle (gray Ford Escape) at the dog park and both suspects fled the area. The victim stated that he then got in his vehicle and attempted to search for the suspects. The victim stated that he was driving northbound through Renaissance Commons and entered the parking lot of CVS, 1895 N. Congress Ave, when he noticed officers and flagged them down. The victim confirmed again that the abandoned vehicle on Renaissance Dr was the vehicle that he witnessed the two suspects flee in after he was robbed at gunpoint.

Crime Scene Investigator Stidham processed the abandoned vehicle, taking swabs and lifting four latent prints from the interior. CSI Stidham documented and photographed several items left within the vehicle, including a black and red plaid sweatshirt as described by the victim as being worn by the suspect who robbed him.

The following prints were analyzed and identified in the Automated Fingerprint Identification System as belonging to h/m Misael Cifuentes (DOB 06/17/1990): right palm print and right ring fingerprint on a Smartwater bottle located in the center console cup holder, right palm print on the inside of the front driver side window, and a right thumb print on a TCL cell phone recovered from the driver seat.

Contact was made with the owner of the stolen vehicle (witness 1), and it was learned that her husband had lent the vehicle to a Hispanic male known as "Smoke" who she described as having tattoos all over his neck and face to include a distinct tattoo between his eyes; this description is consistent with Cifuentes. Witness 1 had since recovered her vehicle after BBPD had towed it, and she stated that several items were left inside that did not belong to her. She provided consent to search her vehicle at which time I recovered a black and red plaid jacket that matched the description of that worn by the suspect during the robbery. The jacket was shown to the victim and he immediately uttered, "that is what he was wearing when he robbed me." This jacket was processed and DNA from the cuffs came back to Misael Cifuentes.

A pawn database search revealed that Cifuentes had sold the victim's gold chain and pendant on 4/14/20 at Value Pawn and Jewelry in West Palm Beach. Cifuentes is a seven time convicted felon

Based on the aforementioned, I find probable cause to charge Cifuentes with one count of Armed Robbery with a Firearm in violation of F.S.S. 812.13(2)(a), one count of Dealing in Stolen Property in violation of F.S.S. 812.019(1), one count of False Verification of Ownership in violation of F.S.S. 539.001(b), and one count of Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon in violation of F.S.S. 790.23(1)(a).
