


On Tuesday, October 12th, 2021 at approximately 1650 hours officers were dispatched to 3531 S Federal Highway #G (Seabourne Cove Apartments) in reference to a stolen vehicle in progress. While en-route, dispatch advised that the caller stated she was delivering a pizza and her black 2016 Kia Optima was taken by a B/M suspect who was pretending to order the pizza.

Upon arrival, Officer Corum made contact with the victim identified as B/F provided a sworn BWC statement at which time she stated that she is a delivery driver for Papa John's and was delivering a pizza to a "Donald Leighfort" who used a phone number of 561-524-2357 and provided an address of 3531 S Federal Highway #G. stated that she parked in a visitor spot directly in front of unit G to wait for the subject to meet her by her vehicle to deliver the pizza. stated that she never saw anyone exit apartment #G. stated that she then observed a B/M approximately 5'7" thin build, mid 20's, wearing a navy blue "polo" style hat, a blue/black long sleeve dry fit shirt, blue swim trunks, and sneakers. was very intricate on the suspect description to include that the shirt was a "guy Harvey style shirt". stated the male came from the southern end of the development and walked by her vehicle, which did not have a "Papa Johns" sign on it advised that the male was staring at his phone and then turned and asked her "Papa Johns?" in which she replied yes. stated the male then proceeded to point a small black style handgun in her direction and proceeded to tell her to get out of the vehicle. stated that there seemed to be something off with the male as he repeatedly began to apologize to her for what he was doing. stated the male then pushed her out of the vehicle at which time she dropped the pizza and fell on the ground, thus causing a small scrape to her right elbow and to her right knee. refused any medical treatment and photos were taken via officer Corum's BWC. The suspect then gained possession of her vehicle and drove out of the neighborhood towards Old Dixie Highway. stated that the suspect was in possession of the only keys to the vehicle and that there was no personal property of value within the vehicle with the exception of \$200.00 cash in the center console. stated she would be able to identify the suspect should she see him again. stated that she wishes to press charges and gave permission on my BWC for BBPD to enter her vehicle to conduct crime scene. It should be noted that: advised that she was in fear for her life during the encounter.

While on scene, Officer Corum made contact with the property manager Raquel Leung who stated that the video surveillance cameras facing the crime scene are not operational. LEUNG also provided Officer Corum with information for residents of unit # B which is directly above unit #G. LEUNG stated that there is a B/M who is the grandson of the residents Irma Sulamain (561-706-6711) and Bin Sulamain (561-251-5336). LEUNG stated the male whose description matches the one provided to me by occasionally stays in his car (unknown vehicle) in the neighborhood and uses the amenities.

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


Minutes after the 911 call from Sgt Munro located the stolen black Kia Optima parked in the area of Cherry Hill Mini Market (504 NW 12th Avenue, Boynton Beach, FL). The vehicle was parked unoccupied and was locked. I then responded to the area of Cherry Hill Mini Mart to review video surveillance.

It should be noted that the time stamp on the video surveillance was determined to be 4 hours slow from actual time. When the time stamp displays the time of 1257 hours it displays events that occurred at 1657 hours real time. Upon reviewing the video surveillance, 8 minutes after the 911 call, I observed a B/M who matched the exact description provided by the victim walk from the vehicle carrying numerous items. The male was wearing the same "guy Harvey" style shirt, blue shorts, and white Jordan style shoes. The male then began frantically walking around the store as if he was extremely nervous. The male suspect then removed his shirt and placed it in the dumpster as if he was attempting to change his appearance. The male suspect then made multiple trips from the vehicle to the dumpster located on the north side of the building throwing out items from the vehicle. At one point during the video, you can clear see the male carrying a white book with a red "KIA" logo imprinted on it. The male then observed Sgt Munro's vehicle traveling northbound on NW 4th Street at which time he immediately attempted to conceal himself behind the business front door. The male suspect then fled eastbound on NW 11th Avenue after he was no longer in sight of Sgt Munro's vehicle. Crime Scene responded and then recovered multiple items from the dumpster as well as another trash can nearby. These items included correspondents (Mail) with the victim's name on it, the black long "guy Harvey" t-shirt that the suspect was wearing, as well as the KIA Optima owners manual. Due to the fact that the vehicle was locked and the whereabouts of the keys were unknown, Beck's was notified at which time the vehicle was towed to BBPD for crime scene processing. The suspect was displayed in the area of Cherry Hill Mini Mart eight minutes after the 911 call, which is around the time for travel from the area of the incident to this location.

While reviewing the very detailed surveillance video from the business, I immediately identified that male as B/M Khalil Wilderson, due to the fact that I had just conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that he was operating just weeks prior. A database search revealed that Detective Autiello also conducted a traffic stop on Wilderson a couple months prior. Detective Autiello also identified the male suspect in the video as Wilderson. was then provided a photo lineup with Wilderson included, however she was not able to successfully identify anyone in the lineup. Due to the traumatizing order of events, coupled with a firearm pointed at face, it is likely that she may have been fixated on the gun and not Wilderson's face. It should be noted that the video surveillance from the store is extremely clear and I was even able to identify face tattoos of Wilderson as well as additional tattoos on his back area.

I then captured a still photo from the video surveillance located at the store where Wilderson was seen coming from the vehicle. The photo did not include Wilderson's face, but include the clothing that he was wearing. Upon placing the photo in front of she without hesitation stated "That is the guy" and continued to state "that is 100 percent the guy". also made mention that the clothing was the same "guy Harvey" style shirt, blue shorts, and white Jordan shoes that she observed during the encounter. went on and advised that she didn't know why he was wearing such nice shoes with a "guy harvey" style shirt on. without doubt believed that Wilderson was then suspect that he stole her vehicle.

Based on the above facts, I find probable cause to charge B/M Khalil Wilderson with 1F count of Armed Carjacking pursuant to FSS 812.133(1)and(2)(a).
