Detectives of the Boynton Beach Police Department's Violent Crimes Task Force (VCTF) made contact with BBPD Confidential Source 20-038, hereinafter referred to as "CS". CS stated that he/she could purchase crack cocaine from B/M Spencer Alexander Brooks. CS contacted Brooks via telephone (561- 305-9475) and arranged a meeting to purchase \$40.00 (Investigative Funds) worth of crack cocaine. Brooks agreed to sell the CS \$40.00 worth of crack cocaine and directed him to meet at his residence (217 NW 7th CT).


Detectives then setup in an undisclosed location and began to conduct surveillance, prior to the CS arriving in the area. CS was searched for any drugs, money and/or contraband, yielding negative results. CS was provided with \$40 of investigative funds (IF) (Twenty Dollar Bills Serial #PF71341786C /PK43344234C) and dropped off at an undisclosed location before approaching the area.

Detective Barrios and I were watching/monitoring CS from an undisclosed location. CS then arrived at the residence of Brooks 217 NW 7th CT and made contact with Brooks. CS then provided Brooks with \$40.00 IF and in return, Brooks provided CS with (2) small pieces of suspected crack cocaine. Brooks after completing the deal was observed walking back to his residence of 217 NW 7th Ct.

CS immediately left the area and met with Detectives at an undisclosed location. CS provided me with (2) small loose pieces of crack cocaine. CS made no stops and no other contacts with any person once throughout the above incident. CS was again search for drugs, money and/or contraband, again yielding negative findings. I then conducted a field test on the suspected cocaine, yielding a positive reaction for cocaine (0.4 grams NET). I placed the contraband into BBPD evidence. During the buy-walk operation, Detectives never lost visual and/or communication with CS. Investigation on-going.



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

CS was searched for any drugs, money and/or contraband, yielding negative results. CS was provided with \$40 of investigative funds (IF) dropped off at an undisclosed location before approaching the area.

Detective James and I were watching/monitoring CS from an undisclosed location. CS then arrived at the residence of Brooks 217 NW 7th CT and made contact with Brooks. CS then provided Brooks with \$40.00 IF and in return, Brooks provided CS with (2) small pieces of suspected crack cocaine. Brooks after completing the deal was observed walking back to his residence of 217 NW 7th Ct.

CS immediately left the area and met with Detectives at an undisclosed location. CS provided me with (2) small loose pieces of crack cocaine. CS made no stops and no other contacts with any person once throughout the above incident. CS was again search for drugs, money and/or contraband, again yielding negative findings. I then conducted a field test on the suspected cocaine, yielding a positive reaction for cocaine (0.4 grams NET). I placed the contraband into BBPD evidence. During the buy-walk operation, Detectives never lost visual and/or communication with CS.

Based on the above aforementioned facts, I find probable cause to charge Brooks with Sale of Cocaine pursuant to 893.13.1A1, Possession of Cocaine with Intent to Sale within 1000ft of a Church pursuant to F.S.S 893.13.1C1, Use of a Two-Way Communication Device pursuant to F.S.S 934.215, and Unlawfully Rent Property for Sale of Controlled Substances pursuant to F.S.S 893.1351.

On Wednesday, February 9, 2022, Violent Crime Task Force Detectives conducted a covert narcotics operation in the City of Boynton Beach, FL.

An undercover Boynton Beach police officer, who was acting in an undercover capacity, herein referred to as UC, was provided with \$40 of investigative funds (JK14600335C & MG50198517G). UC later arrived in the area of 200 NE 13th Avenue in an undercover police vehicle. Please note that this location is a high crime area known for continuous open air narcotic sales/activity and violent crimes. Upon arrival the UC made contact with a heavyset B/M wearing a long sleeve white shirt. The B/M was immediately identified as Isidore Reed Jr by Det. Autiello who observed Reed standing in front of 221 NE 13th Avenue, which is Reed's known residential address.

As Reed approached the UC's vehicle, UC asked if Reed had "hard", Reed responded that not right now and provided UC with a phone number (561-888-7202) and advised he will call UC when ready.

Please note while utilizing the TLO platform a search of the phone number showed it being registered to Isidore Reed. At approximately 1600 hours Reed called UC from (561-888-7202) and advised the UC to come back to 13th.

Prior to the UC arriving back to NE 13th Avenue, Det. Autiello who was on surveillance in the area observed Reed exit the residence of 221 NE 13th Avenue and then directly made contact with the UC who stopped in the roadway in front of 221 NE 13th Avenue. Reed then approached the driver's side window of the UC vehicle at which time the UC provided \$40 of investigative funds to Reed and Reed provided 2 pieces of suspected crack cocaine. After the transaction was complete the UC left the area. The above hand to hand narcotics transaction was captured via covert surveillance equipment.

The UC returned to an undisclosed location where the UC provided me with the (.4 grams of crack cocaine). I transported the suspected crack cocaine to BBPD in my vehicle #3014 where I tested of the suspected crack cocaine utilizing a Sirchie Nark Cocaine ID Swipe, which tested positive. I then submitted the crack cocaine into BBPD evidence per procedure. Please note that the transaction occurred 145.99 feet from Palmetto Green Linear Park (421 NE 13th Avenue) via Google Maps.

Based on the above facts, information and totality of circumstances I find probable cause to charge Isidore Reed with 1 count of Sale of Cocaine within 1000ft of a Park pursuant to F.S.S 893.13(1)(c)(1) and 1 count of Unlawful use of a two-way communication device pursuant to FSS 934.215.



Frederick then made contact with UC at which time UC provided \$40 of investigative funds to Frederick and Frederick provided 2 lose pieces of suspect cocaine. The above hand to hand narcotics transaction was captured via covert surveillance equipment. After the transaction | provided his number | to the UC and the UC left the area.

The UC returned to an undisclosed location where the UC provided me with the (.2 grams of crack cocaine). I transported the suspected crack cocaine to BBPD in my vehicle #3014 where I tested of the suspected crack cocaine utilizing a Sirchie Nark Cocaine ID Swipe, which tested positive. I then submitted the crack cocaine into BBPD evidence per procedure. Please note that the transaction occurred 506 30 feet from Sara Sims Park (209 NE 9th Avenue) via Google Maps. UC later arrived in the area of 400 NW 12th Ave in an undercover police vehicle. Please note that this location is a high crime area known for continuous narcotics sale/use and violent crimes. Upon arrival the UC made contact with a heavy-set B/M wearing all black. The B/M identified as Joe Adams by Det. Autiello who was observed standing out in front of 1213 NW 4th St. (Cherry Hill Mini Mart).

As Adams approached the UC's vehicle the UC asked "You got hard" Adams responded "how much", UC stated "\$40" Adams then told the UC to drive around the block. As the UC arrived back in front of 1213 NW 4th Street, Adams made contact with UC at which time UC provided \$40 of investigative funds to Adams and Adams provided 2 lose pieces of suspect cocaine. Adams then provided his number (561-572-5142) to the UC. The above hand to hand narcotics transaction was captured via covert surveillance equipment.

Please note while utilizing the TLO platform a search of the phone number showed it being registered to Joe Adams.



The UC returned to a an undisclosed location where the UC provided me with the (.3 grams of crack cocaine). I transported the suspected crack cocaine to BBPD in my vehicle #3014 where I tested of the suspected crack cocaine utilizing a Sirchie Nark Cocaine ID Swipe, which tested positive. I then submitted the crack cocaine into BBPD evidence per procedure.

UC was then shown a familiarization photo of Joe Adams confirming that he was the male who sold the crack cocaine.

Please note that the transaction occurred 633.99 feet from Wilson Park (225 NW 12th Ave) and 805.78 feet from Barton Memorial Park via Google Maps.

Based on the above facts, information and totality of circumstances I find probable cause to charge Joe Adams with sale of cocaine within 1000ft of a Park pursuant to F.S.S 893.13(1)(c)(1).

On Thursday, February 17, 2022 at approximately 1850hrs, Violent Crime Task Force Detectives conducted a covert narcotics operation in the City of Boynton Beach, FL. Detective Autiello utilized information obtained from a recent overdose investigation and cold texted the phone number of (561-703-1643). Detective Autiello and the person agreed to meet KFC (131 E Boynton Beach Blvd) for 3 caps for \$60. Please note that caps are slang for Heroin/ Fentanyl.

Please note while utilizing the TLO platform a search of the phone number showed it being registered to Timothy Foreman of 424 NE 1st Street. This registered address in approximately 2 blocks north of the meeting location provided to Detective Autiello.

An undercover Boynton Beach police officer, who was acting in an undercover capacity, herein referred to as UC, was provided with \$60 of investigative funds (MB77975560I, NJ12261273A & NB48968488A). UC later arrived to the meeting location of KFC (131 E Boynton Beach Blvd) in an undercover police vehicle. Please note that this location is a high crime area known for continuous narcotics sale/use and violent crimes. The unknown person then texted the UC stating "Come to me I'm at my people house come down that street". The unknown person then called the UC and directed the UC to 424 NE 1st Street.

Det. Autiello who was on surveillance in the area observed B/M known to him through numerous prior encounters as B/M Timothy Foreman exit the residence of 424 NE 1st Street and then directly made contact with the UC who stopped in the roadway in front of 424 NE 1st Street.

Foreman then approached the front passengers side window of the UC vehicle at which time the UC provided \$60 of investigative funds to Foreman and Foreman provided 3 red baggies of suspected fentanyl. After the transaction was complete the UC left the area. The above hand to hand narcotics transaction was captured via covert surveillance equipment.

Detective Montoute then observed B/M Isidore Reed exit the front door of 221 NE 13th Avenue. Reed then proceeded to make contact with UC.

While speaking with Reed, the UC provided \$40 of investigative funds to Reed and Reed provided lose pieces of suspect cocaine. The above hand to hand narcotics transaction was captured via covert surveillance equipment.

Detective Montoute then observed Reed return to the residence 221 NE 13th Avenue without making any further stops. The UC returned to an undisclosed location where the UC provided me with the (.6 grams of crack cocaine). I transported the suspected crack cocaine to BBPD in my vehicle #3014 where I tested of the suspected crack cocaine utilizing a Sirchie Nark Cocaine ID Swipe, which tested positive. I then submitted the crack cocaine into BBPD evidence per procedure.

Please note that the transaction occurred 145.99 feet from Palmetto Green Linear Park (421 NE 13th Avenue) via Google Maps. Based on the above facts, information and totality of circumstances I find probable cause to charge Isidore Reed with 1 count of Sale of Cocaine within 1000ft of a Park pursuant to F.S.S 893.13(1)(c)(1) and 1 count of Unlawful use of a two-way communication device pursuant to FSS 934.215.




Please note that the tag is registered to Foreman but assigned to a different model vehicle. Foreman then exited his vehicle and approached the UC vehicle via foot.

Please note that the can's top was ripped off the top of the can was located inside the toilet bowl and the concrete coating from the inside of the can on the ground, which is consistent with someone attempting to destroy evidence. (Located and collected by Detective Grigorian)
- Black Cell phone with a wallet style case which contained B/M Corey Barber DOC ID Card. (Located and collected by Detective Grigorian)

Please note that throughout the residence Detectives observed adult male clothing and numerous documents of correspondents for B/M Corey Barber.

The recovered evidence was then transported to BBPD by Sergeant Kautz and transferred to Detectives Barrios and Montoute. I then submitted the cocaine into BBPD evidence.

UC was then shown a familiarization photo of Jerome Inman confirming that he was the male who sold the crack cocaine.

Based on the above facts, information and totality of circumstances I find probable cause to charge Jerome Inman with 1 count of sale of cocaine pursuant to F.S.S 893.13(1)(a)(1), and 1 count of Unlawful use of a two-way communication device pursuant to FSS 934.215.

On Wednesday, April 20, 2022, Violent Crime Task Force Detectives conducted a covert narcotics operation in the City of Boynton Beach, FL.



An undercover Boynton Beach police officer, who was acting in an undercover capacity, herein referred to as UC, was provided with \$40 of investigative funds (MA20221934B & ME61683373E). UC arrived in the area of 100 NE 10th Avenue in an undercover police vehicle. Please note that this location is a high crime area known for continuous open-air narcotics sales/activity and violent crimes. Upon arrival the UC made contact with a B/M wearing a brown shirt and a blue hair cap. I was able to immediately identify the male as B/M Michael Braddy.

As Braddy approached the vehicle the UC asked Braddy "You got hard, \$40". Braddy then walked out of view to the front of 128 NE 10th Avenue. Braddy then returned to UC vehicle and made contact with UC at which time UC provided \$40 of investigative funds to Braddy and Braddy provided 1 lose piece of suspect cocaine. The above hand to hand narcotics transaction was captured via covert surveillance equipment.

The UC returned to an undisclosed location where the UC provided me with the (.2 grams of crack cocaine). I transported the suspected crack cocaine to BBPD in my vehicle #3014 where I tested of the suspected crack cocaine utilizing a Sirchie Nark Cocaine ID Swipe, which tested positive. I then submitted the crack cocaine into BBPD evidence per procedure. UC was then shown a familiarization photo of Michael Braddy confirming that Braddy was the man that sold the UC cocaine.

Based on the above facts, information and totality of circumstances I find probable cause to charge Michael Braddy with 1 count of Sale of Cocaine pursuant to F.S.S 893.13(1)(a)(1).



On the above date and time, Violent Crimes Task Force Detectives utilized a Confidential informant, herein referred to as "CI", and an under cover Police Officer, herein referred to as "UC", in attempt to conduct a controlled narcotics buy from known narcotics dealer B/M Eddie Rumph (DOB 3/5/95). Through on going investigations, VCTF confirmed Rumph is utilizing his silver 2017 Infiniti SUV bearing FL tag# 81AAKS, which he is the registered of, to both transport narcotics and conduct narcotic transactions out of. Rumph is using cell phone number 561-762-8589, which is also registered to him, to orchestrate narcotic transactions with various users.

The UC requested \$60 worth of heroin at which time the CI conducted a controlled phone call to Rumph's cell phone, 561-762-8589. Rumph answered the phone and asked the CI what they needed at which time the CI requested "\$60 caps", which is street slang for \$60 worth of heroin in pill capsule form. Rumph agreed and provided the CI and UC a meeting location within the Boynton Beach City limits, which the CI and UC agreed to and told the CI to go to the area now. VCTF Detectives conducted a search of both the CI and there vehicle confirming they were not in possession of any illegal contraband. The UC was provided with \$60 in investigative funds per procedure (SN# NJ29142023A, MD89157220E, ME88065905E). VCTF took several security/surveillance positions around the agreed meeting location as the UC and CI arrived. A short time later, Rumph called the CI and advise them he was pulling at which time I observed Rumph silver Infiniti bearing FL tag# 81AAKS, enter the area. As Rumph parked, he instructed the CI to walk to over to his vehicle. The UC provided the CI with the investigative funds at which time the CI walked over to Rumph's vehicle and entered the front passenger seat. Once the CI entered Rumph's vehicle, Rumph provided the CI with the 3 capsules of heroin (0.5 grams), at which time the CI provided him with \$60. Once the narcotics transaction was completed, the CI exited Rumph's vehicle and walked directly back to the UC and provided the narcotics to the UC. Rumph left the area traveling north bound stopping at various locations in attempt to detect if Law Enforcement was following him. VCTF Detectives made contact with the UC and CI in an undisclosed location where a secondary search was conducted and the narcotics were recovered.

I conducted a field test of the suspect heroin utilizing a Fentanyl Reagent field test kit which tested positive for Fentanyl. The narcotics were submitted to BBPD evidence per procedure by myself.

Based on the totality of the above listed facts, I find probable cause to charge defendant Eddie Rumph with sale of Fentanyl pursuant to FSS 893.13.1A1 and misuse of a two way communication device pursuant to FSS 934.215.



On the above date and time, Violent Crimes Task Force Detectives, (VCTF), located B/M Eddie Rumph (DOB 3/5/95), operating his 2017 silver Infiniti QX30 bearing FL tag# 81AAKS in the area of 600 NE 2nd St. It should be noted, I had active PC along with a active search warrant for the said vehicle reference BBPD case# 22-002759.

Rumph parked at the 600 block of 600 block of NE 2nd St. After a short amount of time, Rumph exited his vehicle and began walking east bound at which time K9 Officers Roedel and Vargas in their marked BBPD units, pulled up to Rumph at which time he immediately began walking back towards his vehicle in a hasty manner. At this time, both K9 Officer Roedel and Vargas gave Rumph multiple verbal commands to stop walking away which he ignored and continued to his vehicle. Rumph was able to make it to the driver seat of the said vehicle and attempted to close the door on K9 Officer Vargas in attempt to flee the area, but K9 Officer Vargas was able to stop the door. At this point K9 Officer Vargas continued to give Rumph verbal commands to step out of the vehicle as he was trying to escort him out, but Rumph continued to refuse and tensed up his arms and body. K9 Officers Vargas and Roedel were able to escort Rumph out of the driver seat at which time K9 Officer Vargas and I were able to escort Rumph to the ground. While attempt to place Rumph in handcuffs, he continued to actively resist by tensing up his body and pulling his arms away. After a brief struggle we were able to take Rumph into custody with out further incident. While conducting a search incident to arrest of Rumph, I located a knotted plastic bag containing the following pills, 3 white circles pills "RP 1035" identified as Acetaminophen Oxycodone Hydrochloride, 11 blue bar shaped pills "B707", identified as 2mg Alprazolam, and 3 oval orange pills "153", identified as 8mg Buprenorphine Hydrochloride, all via the poison control website, in his front right small change pocket. While continuing my search of Rumphs person, I was attempting to search the lower half on his right side, but he continued to blade his body away, acted as if he was going to fall over, and refused to turn towards be at which time I noticed a large bulge at the knee of his right pant let. As I checked the said area, I recovered a black Glock 26 SN# BBXP815 loaded with 10 9mm rounds and one in the chamber. It should be noted, the firearm was upside down facing towards me which was consistent with the firearm falling from Rumphs waistband down into his pant leg as he was attempting to resist Officers. Rumph was also n possession of the vehicle keys, and \$806 .00 in U.S. currency. Becks Towing responded to the scene and brought the vehicle back to BBPD where VCTF Detectives executed the search warrant.



While conducting a search of the vehicle, the following was recovered:

- Two individual knotted plastic bags containing crack cocaine (1 bag 2.1 grams 2nd bag 1.6 grams), concealed behind a panel beneath the center console area located by Det. Montoute. The cocaine was cut for sale in different sized, one bag contained \$20 size peices and the 2nd contained \$50 pieces.
- 1 cell phone on the center console area with narcotic related texts messages on the screen. I called the number Rumph utilized to conduct past narcotic transactions on, 561-762-8589, at which time the cell phone rang confirming it was in fact the same phone.
- A second cell phone located in the back seat of the vehicle.

I conducted a N/FCIC check of Rumph yielding negative results for wants or warrants. I conducted a criminal history of Rumph confirming he was a 3 time convicted felon with 1

Based on the totality of the above listed facts, I find probable cause to charge defendant Eddie Rumph with 3 counts of possession of a controlled substance with out a prescription pursuant to FSS 893.13.6A, possession of cocaine with intent to sell pursuant to FSS 893.13.1A1, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon pursuant to FS 790.23.1A, and resisting arrest with out violence pursuant to FSS 843.02.

The recovered cocaine was field tested which tested positive. All the recovered contraband was submitted to BBPD evidence per procedure by Det. Montoute and Barrios. Photos were taken of Rumph for documentation purposes. Rumph was TOT PBCJ. Nothing further.
