Abreu stated she is unemployed but attends college on-line and is studying "pre-med" with the intent of becoming a doctor. Abreu stated she and her boyfriend own a total of seventeen (17) dogs of various breeds, including "Snow". Abreu stated they breed the dogs and sell puppies. Abreu admitted neither she nor her boyfriend possess a Hobby Breeder permit (as required by local ordinance) and she also admitted they do not provide veterinary health certificates when they sell dogs/puppies (as required by state statute). Abreu stated she and her boyfriend acquired "Snow" approximately four months ago from a breeder in north Florida. Abreu stated the dog has never been seen by a veterinarian while in her and her boyfriend's possession. Abreu stated that at some point, "Snow" developed an unknown medical condition on her paws so her boyfriend took the dog to another breeder for medical advice. Abreu stated she and her boyfriend self-treated the paws and did not seek professional veterinary care. Abreu stated that approximately two weeks ago, she woke up one morning and the dog's right forepaw "was gone". Abreu stated she treated the dog with penicillin she had left over from another dog's c-section surgery and placed a bandage over its leg. Abreu stated she changes the bandage daily and she believes the dog has greatly improved. Abreu readily admitted she is aware of the fact the dog's bone is protruding from its leg and she readily admitted she chose not to seek veterinary treatment.

Abreu stated she recently had an outbreak of the parvo virus at her home so she took all of her and her boyfriend's dog/puppies, with the exception of "Snow", to Best Vet Animal Hospital for treatment and safe-keeping while she was in the process of cleaning

Abreu also admitted she used a hose to clean the dog's feces out of the crate while the dog was still in it (as observed by the anonymous caller). After a lengthy discussion, Abreu agreed to relinquish custody of "Snow". Abreu was given an opportunity to relinquish custody of the sixteen dogs/puppies that were housed at Best Vet Animal Hospital, but she adamantly refused to do so. After the interview, I received a phone call from Abreu's boyfriend who identified himself as Christopher Jamal Miller. At my request, Miller subsequently provided a copy of his driver's license via text to confirm his identity. I spoke with Miller in length on 10/30/21, as well as multiple times over the course of the following three days. Miller claimed ownership of "all of the dogs", including "Snow". Miller stated he resides with Abreu, but he was working out of town at this time. Miller stated he was last at Abreu's residence approximately two weeks ago and he admitted he was aware that "Snow" had a leg injury. Miller stated he had sought medical advise/treatment from an out-of-town breeder (as told by Abreu). Miller stated all of his dogs are his "emotional support animals" and he identified "Snow" as being his primary emotional support dog. Miller stated he and Abreu take excellent care of their animals and routinely take them to numerous veterinarians. When I asked Miller for the names of the veterinarians, he replied "I don't really know". Miller was given multiple opportunities to relinquish custody of "Snow" and/or any of the other sixteen (16) dogs/puppies but he adamantly refused to do so. On 11/06/21, Miller ultimately relinquished his ownership rights to "Snow". On 11/23/21, Palm Beach County Animal Care and Control staff veterinarian Dr. Sara Chapman, DVM, provided a written report detailing the health and physical condition of "Snow" upon intake on 10/28/21. Dr. Chapman nestimated the initial i
